• **Free Shredding** - Would you like to have your personal documents disposed of in a safe and secure manner? Bring us your unwanted paper documents and watch us shred them on-site for free.

Available to Gary residents, schools, churches, and small businesses **from 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. only.**

• **The Gas Can Exchange Program** - Bring in an old gas can to exchange for a new, environmental friendly 2.5 Gallon gas can. **Gas cans are free**, but you must bring in an old gas can to receive a new one. **\*Limit one gas can per person.** The Gas Can Exchange Program is provided by NIRPC.

• **Tire Collection** - Please collect and bring old tires for proper disposal. Help us to declutter our neighborhoods and our city. This service is offered to the citizens of Gary only.

- Arsenic,
- Herbicides, Fertilizers,
- Insecticides, insect repellent,
- Poisons and rodent killer.

- **Free Recycle Bins** - The Gary Recycling Department will distribute new recycling bins to Gary residents.
- **E-Recycling** - The Gary Recycling Department will collect electronic items to include computers, VCR/DVDs, cell phones, fax machines, video game consoles, cable boxes, modems, wireless devices, and electronic medical equipment from Gary residents, schools, churches, and small businesses.
