GARY 5X5X5 COMMUNITY CLEAN UP ANNOUNCED IN 5TH DISTRICT

Gary, Indiana-The Mayor's Office of Constituent Services (MOCS) and 5TH District Councilwoman Linda Barnes-Caldwell announce Community Clean-Up Day on Thursday, July 6, 2017. The boundaries for the clean-up are 33rd Avenue to 38th Avenue, Virginia Street to Massachusetts Street.

The clean-up from 8:00 a.m. to 2:00 p.m. is part of the City's Gary for Life 5X5X5 Revitalization Project. Residents in the Fifth District are encouraged to join City departments in the clean-up effort by cutting grass and by working together in their neighborhoods to spruce up their blocks. Residents may also volunteer to help with the neighborhood cleanup. Participants and volunteers are asked to meet at the Gleason Clubhouse at 3400 Jefferson Street for assignments.

Cleaning Supplies will be provided but volunteers are also encouraged to bring their own rakes, shovels, brooms, gloves, garbage bags, etc.

Participating departments include General Services, Parks, Demolition, Code Enforcement, Police, Fire, Traffic, Green Urbanism, Recycling, Health and Building.
